### \*\* ACSI Offering

One of our supported missions organizations, the Association of Christian Schools International (ACSI), recently contacted its financial partners regarding its four partner schools on Maui (see below). The schools were not physically damaged by the recent fires, but the families whose children attend the schools have been drastically harmed. ACSI has set up a Disaster Reconstruction Fund to provide aid to families adversely affected by the fires and has invited its financial partners to help.

This Sunday we will take a special offering for the ACSI Disaster Reconstruction Fund. The Missions Committee will match up to \$500 that are given by the congregation. If you are giving by check, please make it out to the church but designate it to "ACSI Disaster Reconstruction Fund" in the memo line.
