Answered Prayers for a Miracle from Guatemala

The surgical trips to Guatemala have been on hold after Covid. The government imposed some new rules for projects like HTI. They are now requiring us to have a fully operational medical laboratory, even though we are not a 24/7 hospital, only opening for surgery when we send teams there. When they give the hospital license, the legal representative must sign that letter of commitment to finish and approve the lab license within two years. We are approved as of this moment to continue with normal surgical and hospital operations. We could be ready for February or March in Guatemala, but we know that physicians and nurses must be contacted with a concrete response.

This is without a doubt God opening doors and providing us a means to get back to part of our core mission. Thank you for your continued prayers, patience, and support during this process. The Lord be praised! *Kemmel Dunham*
