### From the Pastor's Pen

Greetings Central Family & Friends. We are a quarter of the way through this year and several weeks into the Lenten Season. I hope you are growing in faith and enjoying the presence of God's love and grace in your daily lives. Our Sanctuary Renovation Committee presented the final concept drawings during the Town Hall meeting on Sunday, March 12, along with the proposal from the Finance Team to pay for the renovation project. Our heartfelt thanks to everyone involved in this project for your dedication and sacrifice. We have so much more to do in realizing the vision of this renovation project and I am certain that God will lead and guide us through the servant leaders of Central to finish this project. I hope you will join in praying and committing to the project from the beginning to the end.

Palm Sunday, the Holy Week, and Easter are all approaching very quickly and Central is preparing for the remembrance of our Savior's suffering & death, and the celebration of Jesus' resurrection from the dead. On Thursday, April 6th at 6:30pm, we will gather with our sister presbyterian churches to remember the suffering and death of our Lord in a Maundy Thursday/Good Friday worship service. The location of this joint service will be at Central sanctuary. Then we will gather on Easter morning at 10:30am to celebrate the resurrection of Jesus Christ. Easter is a reminder and encouragement from God that believers of Jesus Christ can enjoy the life of heaven before we enter the gates of heaven after our death.

N.T. Wright said, "Jesus' resurrection is the beginning of God's new project, not to snatch people away from earth but to colonize earth with the life of heaven." People who rejected Jesus as the Messiah did not understand the meaning of 'kingdom of God on earth' through the resurrection of Christ. Luke 17:20~21... Being asked by the Pharisees when the kingdom of God would come, he answered them, "The kingdom of God is not coming in ways that can be observed, nor will they say, 'Look, here it is!' or 'There!' for behold, the kingdom of God is in the midst of you." Jesus was not saying that the kingdom of God resided within the Pharisees' hearts. The Pharisees opposed Jesus and had no relationship with God. Jesus was telling the Pharisees that He brought the kingdom of God to earth to those who believe in Him. Jesus' presence in their midst gave them a taste of the kingdom life, as attested by the miracles that Jesus performed. The kingdom of God is in your midst in the person and presence of Jesus, who was inaugurating the kingdom as He changed the hearts of men, one at a time. I pray that you will experience the kingdom of God on earth as you celebrate the resurrection of our Savior, Jesus Christ, on Easter and beyond.
