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In Exodus 3 God calls Himself the “I Am.” This Burning Bush moment is pivotal in redemptive history. God reveals Himself to Moses, and subsequently to His people and comes to redeem them out of bondage and exile in Egypt and lead them into new life. I AM reveals who God is and what He is like — eternal and unchanging, infinite and glorious, above and beyond all things. I AM is God. When Jesus applies “I AM” to himself, Jesus reveals who He is and what He is like. Jesus reveals Himself to be God.

I AM the Light of the World, John 8:12

I AM the Resurrection and the Life, John 11:25-26

- 4 Is there an area of your life that you find it hard to (completely) trust that Jesus understands and can make a difference? Why?

I AM the Way, the Truth, and the Life, John 14:6

- 5 What are the different views about Jesus? How do they line up with what Jesus has said about himself?
- 6 How is Jesus the Way? What does it mean to follow the Way, or go the Way, of Jesus?
