0 → We've spent a few weeks around the conversation of the Pharisee's Minimums and Jesus' (Kingdom) Maximums. → What does this mean? (cf: Luke 15:16:16-18)

## Matthew 5:38-47

- 1 → What is the "law" being presented here?
- $2 \rightarrow$  How is the law being interpreted by the people?

(B→ How does Jesus fulfill this law? (Remember, as Jesus is using this word, fulfill first and foremost means to rightly interpret.)

 $4 \rightarrow$  How does Jesus transform our understanding of this law?

 $5 \rightarrow$  Can you remember a time when you have been "the other?" How did it feel? Did it resolve?

(6) → Who is "Other" to you? → So, now what?

✓ Extra credit discussion: Terry has been saying: "We have to ask ourselves NOT, "Did I do the specific things in Jesus' illustrations?" but "Am I being the kind of person Jesus' illustrations are illustrations of?"
