Luke 17:1-2 ¹ Jesus said to his disciples: "Things that cause people to sin are bound to come, but woe to that person through whom they come. ² It would be better for him to be thrown into the sea with a millstone tied around his neck than for him to cause one of these little ones to sin.

- ⊕ Have you ever been "stumbled" by someone? What was the experience like for you?
- 2 → Have you ever been "the stumbler" to someone? What did you learn from the experience?
- ③→ When Jesus says, "It would be better for him to be thrown into the sea with a millstone tied around his neck than for him to cause one of these little ones to sin," is this hyperbole? How is it be better to die an instantaneous, horrific death than to go on causing others to sin?
- ♦ What steps or actions have you ever taken to avoid causing someone to be tripped up in Christ?
- **(5)** → What "disputable issues" are challenging for you to keep from using as a judgement against others?
- **7** → EXTRA CREDIT: What does it mean for you, practically, to accept the one whose faith is weak? Give examples.
