In our *school* community, we all have "Bethany Lutheran School" neighbors, too: folks we pass in the hallway or sit near as we wait to pick up our kids after school. How well are we connecting with our school neighbors, and how can we "love these neighbors as we love ourselves?" Something to consider...


