

NOTES FROM THE

Board of Directors

On June 23rd the Voters' Assembly unanimously approved the proposed 2024/2025 budget. Our new constitution will require a quorum of at least 10% of our average Sunday worship attendance in order to vote on motions. We met this threshold and we want to

thank the 49 members who attended. Please continue to attend future meetings in order to help us meet this threshold. The budget includes a salary adjustment for our staff that we feel shows our continuing commitment to providing for their needs.

On June 24th the Cypress City Council approved the plans for the new Charter School who plan to purchase part of the Holy Cross property. The sale can now move forward. We will keep you informed on when the sale is completed and when renovations on the sanctuary will begin.

Finally, we are happy to report that we will be submitting our proposed new Constitution and Bylaws to our district office within the next week. They will review them and then send their suggested edits, if any, back to us. Again, we will keep you informed of the progress. The Board of Directors will now be moving on to working on Policy updates and our employee benefits package.



SCRIP UPDATES!

Earnings Increase: PetSmart gift cards have increased from 5% to 6%. Shop \$25 physical gift cards, reloadable in \$5 - \$500 amounts. Also available as eGift cards from \$5 - \$500.

Mix It Up Brands (Auntie Anne's, Cinnabon, Jamba) earnings have increased from 6% to 7%. Available in \$25 physical gift cards and in eCards in amounts from \$10 - \$200 amounts.

Sephora earnings have increased from 5% to 6.5%. Available in \$25 physical cards and eGift cards in amounts from \$10 to \$250.

BETHANY'S BENEVOLENCE FUND


