FORMS

Enrollment Forms are available in the school or church office or may be found on the church's website: www.bethanylutheran.org. Enrollment Forms must be filled out completely, signed, and returned to the church office by the date shown on the form. Space is limited.

Please Note: Students will not be guaranteed a lesson slot if Enrollment Form is turned in past the deadline. Students will receive enrollment confirmation one week before their first lesson. Fall lessons begin the week of September 16; Winter Recital is scheduled for Friday, January 17, 2025 at 6:30 pm.

FEES and POLICIES

Each student in the Music Academy will pay a Tuition Fee. Tuition for Fall Semester is \$350.00 per student (for 12 scheduled 30- minute lessons). Students who wish to take longer lessons (45 minutes) will be assessed additional Tuition fees. Half of the Tuition Fee must be paid by the first lesson; the remaining half of Tuition is due by the sixth lesson.

There are no refunds or make-up lessons for any missed lessons on the student's part. A student should attend their scheduled lesson even if his/her instrument or class material is forgotten at home. If the instructor is unable to keep the scheduled lesson, a make-up lesson will be arranged.

Should a situation require that a student withdraw, please inform the Academy Administrator and the instructor. Refunds cannot be made because time is reserved and instructors are hired on a semester basis.

Please refer to the Bethany Lutheran School Parent Handbook regarding checks returned by the bank for Non-Sufficient Funds. Past due accounts may result in suspension of lessons, non-participation in the recital, and/or barring from future enrollment in the Music Academy. Exceptions to the above may be made by the Academy Administrator.

PURPOSE OF THE PROGRAM

Bethany Lutheran Music Academy provides after school instrumental music instruction during the school year. Students study in a Christian environment and are taught by instructors who are professionals in their respective fields.

Instruction at the Music Academy is founded on the firm conviction that music is a gift from God used to express praise to Him. This God-given gift is an invaluable tool which facilitates spreading the Gospel.

Anyone associated with Bethany Lutheran Church or School is encouraged to enroll.

GENERAL INFORMATION

Music instruction will take place on the Bethany campus, Monday through Friday, from approximately 3:15 until 6:30 p.m. Lessons are 30 minutes in length. Students who wish to take lessons which are longer than 30 minutes will be assessed additional Tuition fees. There are 12 scheduled lessons per semester, and one recital at the end of each semester.

The Academy encourages parents to take an active interest in their child's musical instruction; sit in on a lesson, communicate with your child's instructor. (We do request that you make an appointment with instructors so as not to infringe on reserved lesson times.) As a parent of a music student, encourage and support them; compliment them on their progress. Parents should help set up a daily schedule that allows the child to practice the instrument at least 30 minutes a day. These 30 minutes can be divided into two or three smaller segments; consistency is the key to mastering new skills.

Child care before and after each lesson is the responsibility of the parent or guardian. Child care is available through Bethany's Extended Day Care Program. You may contact the director, at 562-496-0611 for more information.

COURSE DESCRIPTION







PIANO

Individual piano instruction is offered for students in grades 2 through high school. It is recommended that a piano or keyboard be available for practice. Rentals are available at local music stores. Music lesson materials will be purchased by the parents. Lessons are scheduled once per week, Monday through Friday.

TRUMPET

Individual trumpet instruction is offered for students in grades 4 through high school. Students must have a trumpet available for practice; rentals are available at local music stores. Lesson materials are to be purchased by the parents. Lessons are scheduled once per week, Tuesdays or Wednesdays.

CLARINET

Individual clarinet instruction is offered for students in grades 4 through high school. Students must have a clarinet available for practice; rentals are available at local music stores. Lesson materials are to be purchased by the parents. Lessons are scheduled once per week, Monday or Thursday.

VOICE

Private voice instruction is available for students in grades 7 through 12. Voice students have the option of taking lessons at Bethany or on the campus of Valley Christian School and must interview with an Instructor before enrolling. Lesson materials will be purchased by the parents. For more information on Voice instruction, please speak with Music Academy Administrator.
