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A Note from the Director

Parents, Grandparents, Guardians, and Family Friends,

THANK YOU for bringing your kids to our church! We are thrilled that you have chosen us to be a partner in your child's faith journey. We have an exciting year ahead of us.

At Community of Grace, we want kids to know that Jesus makes us family. This family is a safe, welcoming place for them to just be kids while learning about *who* this Jesus is that makes us a family. We invite kids to take their first step of faith in Jesus. We also walk with them as they take next steps and develop deep roots of faith.

But it starts with you. We can only do this work because of the love you pour out on them by bringing them to church and reinforcing what they learn at home. We know from first-hand experience that it's not always easy. Sometimes I have to remind myself that coming to church is worth it in spite of the whining, crying, the "I'm boreds," and the inevitable wrestling match of buckling car seats! Because of your dedication, our kids can learn to be the church in a world that needs grace in every corner.

That's why we are here to *support you*. We want to be your partner (not your replacement) when it comes to your kids' faith formation. We hope you will find this booklet helpful as a guide to our partnership in this journey.

OUR MINISTRY PHILOSOPHY

At Community of Grace, our mission is "to be and make disciples of Jesus," taken directly from the Great Commission (Matthew 28:16-20). HISKids Children's Ministry follows this mission by partnering with families in the spiritual education and discipleship of their children from birth to 5th grade. We do this through offering HISKids Sunday School, HISKids in Worship, Vacation Bible School, and other family-oriented special events throughout the year.

WHAT IS THE SUNDAY SCHOOL SCHEDULE?

All families should plan to check-in their kids at the north end of the Commons prior to the 9am services. Nursery, Preschool, and Kindergarten students are dropped off in their classrooms prior to the start of services. 1st-5th grade students join their families for opening worship. Our worship leaders then release them to their teachers around 9:15. Sunday School runs until 10:15.

WHY THE 10:15 PICK-UP TIME?

We end Sunday School a little later than our services to provide more time for a quality faith formation and relationship building experience in our classrooms. The extra time also allows parents to relax and connect with other adults in their church family.

WHAT IS HISKIDS IN WORSHIP?

Research shows that children who see their parents or guardians practicing their faith have a higher chance of maintaining faith into adulthood. That's why, about once a month, usually on the First Sunday (see calendar), kids ages 4 & up join us for the full worship service. This is also why we want our elementary students to experience the first part of our worship services every week.

When children join us in worship, we are giving them a sense of belonging in the greater church community. They are exposed to communal faith elements such as worship, Communion, Baptism, and the preaching of the Word. Attending HISKids in Worship also builds on what kids are learning each week as our church follows the Narrative Lectionary in worship and Sunday School.

We know having kids in "big church" can be a challenge for families, especially with very young or highly active children. Our community welcomes the "joyful noises" children create. We also offer these resources for families:

- + Nursery care for ages 0-3 years is available during both service hours on HISKids in Worship Sundays.
- + Activity bags are provided at worship venue entrances.
- + A Children's Message is almost always included on HISKids in Worship Sundays.
- + Our Community Room is available with a livestream of the service for families who need more wiggle room.

ROCK JAR REWARDS

We know that kids are at a developmental stage where external motivation is more effective than internal motivation. To help kids build faith habits such as Bible memorization, tithing, and coming to church, our HISKids classes earn points each week toward a "Rock Jar Party," where they enjoy extra special treats as a class.

It takes about 150-200 rocks to fill a jar. Kids can earn rocks for the "Rock Jar" by doing any or all of the following each week:


- + Attending HISKids
- + Attending a HISKids in Worship Sunday (when applicable)
- + Bringing their Bible to HISKids
- Reciting the Monthly Memory Verse to their teacher
- Bringing an offering to HISKids (All money collected at HISKids goes toward supporting our Mission of Hope sponsor child.)
- + Bringing a friend to HISKids (Earns 3 rocks!)

Our hope is that you as parents/guardians will partner with us in encouraging kids to make these practices a regular part of their week. Of course, we are a community of grace, not guilt or shame. That means things like providing Bibles to use in class if kids forget to bring one or helping them when they miss a word of the memory verse. Also, when a **Rock Jar Reward** is earned, **ALL** students are welcome to partake in the treats!

CATECHISM CONNECTIONS

Alongside our regular week-to-week curriculum, each elementary HISKids class does a year-long study of foundational faith topics. For classes with multiple grade levels, the topics rotate each year. During this program year:

- + 1st & 2nd Graders will explore Personal Prayer & Devotions
- + 3rd & 4th Graders will explore Bible Basics
- 5th Graders will explore & memorize
 The Apostles' Creed



We want kids to learn *what* these topics mean, *why* they are foundational to our faith, and *how* they apply to our everyday lives. Each student will receive a gift to assist in this process:

- + 1st & 2nd Graders will receive a daily devotional book for kids.
- + 3rd & 4th Graders will receive a Bible (New Living Translation) and/or a Bible Basics study book.
- + 5th graders will receive a copy of Luther's Small Catechism and a personal devotional book about Jesus.

You will receive a letter from your child's teacher with more details when the books are distributed in each class.
