Have a Volunteer Read: Romans 10:14-16

Point #1 - We will tell people the gospel, by sending more preachers.

How can you practically be a preacher to others? Discuss a time when you shared the gospel with someone?

Have Another Volunteer Read: Romans 10:17

Point #2 – We must tell more people the gospel, even knowing some will reject it.

"It's not just enough to just live the gospel, we must proclaim it." - Dr. Jeff lorg

How did you hear about the gospel and what was your initial reaction? Why are people so afraid to share the gospel?

Has there been a time when you had the opportunity to share the gospel and you didn't?

Have Another Volunteer Read: Romans 10:18-19

Point #3 – We must clearly communicate the gospel so people are without excuse regarding it.

"We have a responsibility to communicate the gospel. We must make sure people understand it. We must explain it in ordinary words. We must clearly communicate the gospel so that even those who reject it are without excuse." - **Dr. Jeff lorg**

Explain how the gospel affects you on a daily basis and how you can communicate the good news of Jesus Christ through those experiences.

Has there been a time when you shared the gospel and it was rejected?

Have Another Volunteer Read: Romans 10:20-21

Point #4 – We must keep offering the gospel no matter how people respond to us.

"Our work is not about passing judgement on disobeying or defiant people, it's about all day long holding out our hand offering the gospel, no matter how people respond." – **Dr. Jeff lorg**

How can we arm ourselves to overcome the hurdles of sharing the gospel to defiant people? How can we look at our homes as a "mission field" for the gospel?
