Point #2: Every one of us <u>DESERVES GOD'S RIGHTEOUS JUDGMENT.</u>

"These charges are in 3 categories (character, words, conduct). As it is written: "None is righteous, no, not one; (Romans 3:10) Paul begins with the universality of sin. No one is righteous or good or acceptable to God. Everyone needs the gospel. Righteousness is our legal standing before God. Sin has ruined our legal standing before God. When everything is known about who we are, none of us will be in a good place. This includes the most righteous people who have ever lived... Abraham, Moses, Mary, Billy Graham, Mother Teresa, your grandma... whoever it is in your book. When secrets are exposed, it'll be bad for everyone. 24 Just think about it: How would you feel if you had a little monitor on the side of your head so that people could read what your thoughts were at 6 any given moment? The day is coming when all those thoughts get exposed." – **Michael Nolen**

How does Jesus turn those thoughts from the monitor into a testimony?
