DIGGING DEEPER

Have A Volunteer Read: Romans 4:13-15; Galatians 3:24-25 Point #1: What Faith is Not: <u>RIGHTEOUSNESS</u> by Law

"Why would God give a Law if we could never obey it? The Law's job was to *GUARD & INSTRUCT US* – until Christ came. We think Good Works make us acceptable to God. It's just the opposite – it's to show us we'll never be good enough to be acceptable. Through Christ we became justified by faith. Stop asking the Law to do what it wasn't supposed to." – **Chris Thielen**

What are we expecting the Law to do that it was not meant to do? Why is it so hard not to try and find our righteousness in the Law and Good Works?

Have Another Volunteer Read: Romans 4:16-17a, John 1:12 Point #2: What Faith Does: <u>DELIVERS</u> the Promise

"Abraham trusted a specific Promise God made. He adjusted his life around it, because God's Promise had Authority. God's Reputation, made Abraham trust God enough to change his life. Imagine, trusting in your old age that God would give you a son and bless the whole world through it. Imagine moving 550 miles away from family & friends, to a land he'd never seen, to establish a homeland for his family. Descendants that would number as many as the Sand & Stars. That's a bold move for Abraham – not halfway faith – full surrendered trust. Abraham proved he really believed God would deliver on His Promise" – **Chris Thielen**

What would it take for you to believe that enough to change your whole life like that? Discuss why it can be dangerous to treat a wish or expectation like it is a promise from God.

Have Another Volunteer Read: Romans 4:17b-21

Point #3: What Faith Is: Fully CONVINCED God is Able to Do What He Promised

In hope he believed against hope, that he should become the father of many nations, as he had been told, 'So shall your offspring be'. He did not weaken in faith when he considered his own body, which was as good as dead (since he was about a hundred years old), or when he considered the barrenness of Sarah's womb. – Romans 4:18

"Abraham had a choice. He could either believe his eyes – the human impossibility of having kids in his old age, or he could believe the impossibility of God breaking His Word, lying to him. Either way he had to believe something impossible. He chose to trust God over Biology." – **Chris Thielen**

What in your life may be preventing you from fully trusting that God is able to do what he promises?

Have Another Volunteer Read: Romans 4:22-25

Point #4: Who Faith Helps: Those Who <u>BELIEVE</u> in Him Who Raised from the Dead Jesus Our Lord "If you are the kind of person who believes in the God who can bring things back from the dead and can call into existence the things that do not exist, you're going to be a very exciting person to live with. Easier for us than for Abraham – we have the Resurrection to look back on – No Excuse." – Chris Thielen

"You never know when something that does not now exist, will be touched by the grace of God and called into existence. Because he (Abraham) surrendered his trust to God's Promise – Convinced God could do it - God, credited it to him as Righteousness. When we have Faith, Surrendered Trust like Abraham – we get God's Promise. With Faith like that in a God like this -- life is an adventure." – **Chris Thielen**

Has there ever been a time when you surrendered and depended completely on God's promise for something to happen?
