The Adams Rescue Mission - Heidi Acker Promotion and Development Director

The Adams Rescue Mission serves individuals and families through the Agape House Family Shelter, the Men's Shelter, the voucher program, and through the Adopt a Family for Christmas Program. Each client gives us a new opportunity to share the unconditional love of Christ. The family shelter clients attend group and one-on-one Bible Studies weekly, individual counseling, support and prayer anytime they ask for it, and everyone attends a church of their choice on the weekends. Many of these families get connected in their home church, and their children plug in to their youth groups. The individuals and families that are served through our voucher program each come in with their own story, and this gives our staff the chance to minister one-on-one, and often offer prayer and spiritual guidance along with meeting their basic everyday needs like clothing and household goods. The men's shelter clients have daily opportunities to hear the Gospel of Jesus Christ through chapel services, recovery classes, one-on-one counseling sessions, and through interactions at their own home churches. It is our desire that everyone who walks through our doors hears about Christ and feels His love through our ministry.

Adams County Prison Ministry - Angel Perez

Angel Perez is doing a wonderful job as the chaplain at the Adams County Prison. He has started the "Chaplain's Weekly Bible Study". He would like us to pray that all goes well and that it would be a blessing to not only the inmates but to the staff at the prison. It is an opportunity for the staff to practice and prepare for when volunteers begin entering the prison to conduct ministry. Chaplain Perez would like us to pray for the families of the incarcerated people, pray for the volunteer program, and pray for the power of God's kingdom to continue transforming the lives of the leaders, staff, volunteers, and inmates at ACACC.

AWANA - Lanty and Tammie Moss

Lanty and Tammie Moss have been serving with AWANA in Pennsylvania and western Maryland providing leadership to the churches that use the AWANA ministry. They introduce others in how to use it to reach their communities with the gospel message. The children who are exposed to the AWANA ministry are learning so much about God. They are memorizing bible verses that will help them as they grow up in our post-Christian culture. The AWANA clubs are providing many events that have the potential to expose some unchurched families to the gospel message as they come to watch their children compete in "Bible Quizzing games,a Rain Gutter Regatta,or a Grand Prix race. They hope the message will be clearly presented and many will make the greatest decision of their lives at these events.

The Gideons of Pennsylvania - Mark Punchard

The Gideons of Pennsylvania are planning to hold their 118th State Convention in Gettysburg on April 20 -23rd. This will be the first ever state convention to be held in our local area. Our own Mark Punchard is our representative. The Gideons have active camps in 200 countries, territories, and possessions around the world and have distributed over 2 1/2 billion scriptures since their founding 120 years ago.

C.A.R.E.S.

C.A.R.E.S stands for Combined Area Resources for Emergency Shelter. Beginning in October for the past 10 years, the churches in Gettysburg have volunteered to provide shelter to the homeless. They had 10 churches agree to shelter the homeless during the cold months. Each church provides clean mats, blankets, coffee, and breakfast. In the mornings they are driven to the Resource Center to shower, wash clothes, and use computers to find work. They had approximately fourteen guests each night give or take a few. Year to date.(2022 to 2023) the total guests served were 16 men13 women and 1 child. There were 966 cumulative overnights. Cares gave out 1007 vouchers for various things, showers were used 95 times, 229 washer loads used, computers were used 95 times, and 41 bus passes were given. A few churches backed out because of the Covid Vaccination policy. Recently CARES applied for a grant from the ARRF (Adams Response and Recovery Fund). They were rewarded with a large grant. Plans are being made on how best they can serve the homeless. Please pray for guidance from the Lord.

The Buchanans - Nelson and Cheryl

The Buchanans have served 7 years in Taiwan as the leader of WOL (Word of Life). They had 15 missionaries running camps, media outreaches, English outreaches, and English discipleship centers called SYME (School of Youth Ministries in English). Syme was their biggest ministry. It was a 2 month program where students came and learned English and the bible. In 2016 they started a ministry called English Cafe. For 90 minutes each week, they let the community come in and have free English discussion groups that had a biblical focus. Students loved it and it grew. When Covid hit, they moved online. They could reach other countries as well. Now they are in 4 countries, with approximately 400 students every week. The Buchanans now live in Ohio, USA. Recently they just reached their goal of 100 online missionaries who share the Gospel and disciple others from around the world online. This online platform connects English speakers with speakers of other languages who want conversation practice. Using only English and the prompts provided, Online Missionaries can share the truth internationally from their homes.

elder's corner

Have you ever had an amazing teacher? The kind that was extremely intentional with their plan/curriculum, had crazy high expectations, yet at the same time, knew just how to get the very best results out of you in a way that built trust in your teacher's methods and confidence in your own abilities to excel and thrive? That is Jesus. He knows each one of us inside and out, better then any human could ever know us, and He knows the potential we each have to fulfill the good plans He specifically designed for each one of us individually. Below is part of a devotion that explains in greater detail just how great of a teacher our Lord and Savior is, and how we, as his beautiful and purposefully made creation, can have an abiding walk with Him.

Great Teacher

We can know the designer of the Grand Canyon, the human eye, and the Milky Way galaxy. He is alive and well, and he invites us to know him. It is impossible to know the meaning of life if we do not know the Maker of life. Jesus came as our teacher and guide to reveal his heart, his joy, his passion, his plan, and his sorrows. We are not left alone with our wanderings and wonderings.

Yet Jesus doesn't hold his position over our heads. He stoops down to serve us as he shows us what the kingdom of God is like and the way to heaven. And he stands up on our behalf, placing himself between us and those who would accuse us as unworthy of his love, forgiveness, and salvation. When faced with our sin, voices of condemnation awaken in us. Satan tries to steal your peace, kill your dreams, and destroy your future. But he will not have the last word. Jesus has acted on your behalf. He stooped low enough to rub shoulders with the likes of you. Low enough to be crucified and buried. And then he stood up from the slab of death, and he stands up for you.

Wherever God sees sincere seekers with confused hearts, you can bet that he will do whatever it takes to help them see his will. Jesus carries the authority of God to teach us how to live, how to love, how to forgive. But most of all he teaches us why on earth we are on this earth. In this age of information there is much know-how, but hardly any know-why. We need answers. Jesus offers them. But can we trust him? Only one way to know. Seek him out. Lift up your eyes and set your sights on Jesus.

When you enter a difficult experience, trust in Jesus' work. And trust his Word. Don't trust your emotions. Don't trust your opinions. Don't even trust your friends. Heed only the voice of God. Satan will try to raise doubts about God and shift, ever so gradually, your source of confidence away from God's promise and toward your performance. We know his heart and his ways. We rest in him, find our nourishment in him. Abiding in Christ, filling our minds with the truth of God and his goodness brings victory over anxiety and doubt and teaches us about God's faithfulness no matter what our circumstances.
