# **Good Eating**

The great philosopher and theologian George Strait has a great song titled "I Saw God Today" that I want you to listen to as you read this.

We read so many stories in the Bible, some we know well and some that are new to us, that talk about people having interactions with God. Every once in a while, upon reading one of these stories, I get caught up wishing that I could have such an interaction. I find myself asking the question, "Why doesn't God still work like that?" because I feel that I need to see Him face-to-face in whatever situation I may be facing. Exodus 24:8-18 is one of those stories. In this story we find Moses, Aaron, Nadab, Abihu, and seventy other elders going up onto a mountain to have dinner. When they get to the top of that mountain "they saw the God of Israel... and they beheld God, and ate and drank." How cool is that?!?! They actually had a meal on top of a mountain with God! It is so incredible that it is hard to wrap my mind around. I find myself in awe and full of jealousy when I read this story.

According to Mr. Strait, God's "fingerprints are everywhere" and he is certainly onto something there. We may not be able to sit next to God, sharing a cold drink and a bucket of fried chicken (that day is coming, though the menu may be different!), but do not mistake God's presence around a table. Throughout the Bible, we see God gathering with people around a meal, most notably the meal of Holy Communion that we celebrate at worship.

This week, we have opportunities to gather around meals and see God in a couple different ways. First, we have our Shrove Tuesday Pancake Supper on February 21 and God will be there, working through fellowship and community. Join us for pancakes and syrup and see how God is working through your Resurrection family. Then we have our Ash Wednesday service where we are reminded of our need for God's forgiving presence in our lives as we begin our journey with Christ to the cross and the empty tomb. In our evening service, we get to see God's fingerprints in His real presence in, with, and under the bread and wine.

So, while we wait to see God face-to-face join us for a meal and there you will get to see God's work through His people!


# Looking ahead...


# **Christianity: The First 3 Centuries** From Christ to Constantine

decline. I will be praying that God's plans for Resurrection are clear in the upcoming months as you continue to seek a principal.
