Pastor's Corner for June 18-24

You Can Do It (Matthew 9:37-38)

This is Father's Day weekend, a time to give thanks to God for dads, for the sacrifices they make for their children and families, and for all who fill the void of fatherhood when ordinary dads cannot be present. Experience teaches that some fathers excel at their vocation more readily than others. But the best dads do what they can to be strong for their families and they point to God and God's love for them as the ultimate and only long-lasting source of strength and hope.

Jesus was not an ordinary father, of course! But not only did He sometimes call His

disciples "little children" (John 13:33), He would point the way to the Father's ability to use us to accomplish what seems impossible and overwhelming. Today Jesus tells His disciples as He looks with compassion at a crowd in need of healing and leading: "What a huge harvest! How few workers! On your knees and pray for harvest hands!" (Matt 9:38 [MSG]). Of course, Jesus is asking God's "children" to pray. But wasn't He also encouraging them, at the same time? In a sense, He is saying, "The needs out there seem... and at times truly are...overwhelmingly huge! But God answers prayer. He will use your prayers— and perhaps, even you— to accomplish His purposes. With your heavenly Father on your side, you can do it."

Last Wednesday, Rev. Shauen Trump, RLC missionary and LCMS Regional Director for Africa visited the RLC community. He shared so much of what God is doing on the African continent. There are schools where girls— as well as boys— are given a chance to study and prepare for a vocation. There are seminaries where African churches are training future pastors. There are opportunities for mission partners to work together to literally "raise the roof" for new church buildings in places where infrastructure is limited. At the end of his presentation with us, Pastor Shauen reminded us that RLC is connected to the harvest God is providing in Africa through our prayers, financial support, and personal activity in places like Uganda. It was an encouraging message! It was a message not only about the vastness of the harvest, but what God was able to do through folks like you and me.

Whether in Africa or right here at home, it would be easy to see only the needs and feel like doing anything about them is simply too big a job. Where do we start? Jesus tells us there is much God can do in difficult situations and invites us to pray He might raise up workers for his harvest fields. We can't do it alone. Our heavenly Father can— and does. Let's keep praying for more harvest workers. And let's consider what corner of the harvest field God is calling each and every one of us to be at work in.


Summer Adult Christian Ed Class

Our RLC group of 7 youth and 3 adult leaders will be immersed in devotions, serving at our sleeping location, serving the community, and coming together in both our small group and our larger group to give praise each night for the amazing work God is doing within Rutherford County.
