

# "Little Faith" Followers (Matthew 14:22-33)

One summer after college, when I was working as a camp counselor in Michigan, I recall how exhilarated many of the boys in my charge felt to do a lot of things for the first time. These city kids weren't young men— not yet. But in learning how to ride a horse or build a fire or compete in a fun activity, many of them experienced a kind of exhilaration. It was summer camp, after all! Their newfound skill sets made them feel powerful... maybe even a little invincible. So, when it came time to learn basic safety before taking out the canoes on the lake, no one wanted to put on a life jacket! Such a precaution seemed only necessary for lesser mortals.

We don't know what was going through Peter's mind when he took those first

steps outside the boat, but something tells me it was pretty heady stuff. Life can be like that. Starting out with a measure of "success" in our family life, on the job, or even in our calling to share the love of God with others never means we've somehow mastered the chaos of life. Far from it. And if we ever make the mistake of living as if we have, it's just a matter of time before we start to sink. As St. Paul puts it, "if you think you are standing firm, watch out that you don't fall."

Jesus rules the wind and wave! Jesus Himself has even withstood the testing of the Adversary and emerged victorious! As such, He is Lord even over the tempestuous seas of our most overwhelming challenges. One day we will experience in all its fullness the only victory that truly matters: our rescue from the storms of life for all eternity. In the meantime, when we fall, Jesus stretches out His hand and grabs us, always ready to forgive and to set us back on terra firma once again. Together like Peter, we are "little faith" followers. Thank heaven that Jesus' hands are strong enough— and big enough— to always catch us.




