Pastor's Corner for June 9-15, 2024

Our Seeking God (Genesis 3:8-15)

"Where are you?"

When you read those words, how do you hear them in your mind? What emotions are behind the words?

Do you hear a sing-song voice from your childhood as you are hiding under the bed during a high stakes game of hind-and-seek? Is it a voice of exasperation on the other end of the phone after driving in circles for an hour lost beyond belief? Maybe a voice of anger shouting down the hall because you broke your mom's favorite vase and you're terrified of the consequences? You might hear these words

with the weight of sadness because you know the person you're looking for is no longer around to answer. Do you hear a voice of compassion, calling out to you when they know you're lost and all they want to do is help?

"Where are you?" We can hear these words in any number of ways depending on the relationship you have with the speaker. These are the very first words out of the mouth of God after sin has entered the world, "Where are you?" It isn't a statement of disbelief or anger. It isn't a declaration of condemnation. It isn't silence either, which may be expected, it's a question of seeking out those that are lost.

While we can never know the tone of voice God spoke with, the question itself tells us a lot about who God is. Our God is a Seeking God, One who always looks for those who are separated from Him. God would have had every right to strike down Adam and Eve after they ate the fruit, but He didn't. He could have spoken a word and caused all creation to disappear as quickly as it appeared, but He didn't. God went looking with a question of compassion, a word that wanted His people back. Back where? Back in His possession, His protection, His love and mercy.

That is who God is. All throughout the Story of God, we see God seeking. Every time His people fall away, God goes seeking. That is our foundation in this relationship we have with God. We can be confident in our God who seeks. There is never a sin that is too great to make God stop seeking. Adam and Eve invented sin and God went looking for them! If God still loved Adam and Eve after that, think how much love God has for you.

We will always try and hide in our sin. We hide in embarrassment, shame, anger, and hate but God will still seek us out with that little question, "where are you?" And as we answer in the quiet of our hearts or the boldness of our voice, God will hear us, and He will run to us with arms wide open and compassion flowing from His lips, because that's who God is. He is the loving God who always seeks out His people.


Voter's Meeting
