
# Fourth Sunday After Pentecost June 16, 2024



Pastor's Corner for June 16-22, 2024

Our Gardener God (Mark 4:26-34)

Our family loves gardening and what I love most is the surprise of it. You put something so small into the ground and then with care and patience and more than a little bit of love from our Creator God, it grows into something incredible. It might be a beautiful flower that brings some color into the yard throughout the summertime, or it might be a yummy fruit or vegetable to bring color to the dining room table. The garden is where the Sarrault's learn together, fail together, and grow together as a family. It's a lot of fun. It's also a great picture of God's church.

Jesus Himself says the kingdom of God "is like a grain of mustard seed, which, when sown on the ground is the smallest of all the seeds of the earth, yet when it is sown it grows up and becomes larger than all the garden plants and puts out large branches, so that the birds of the air can make nests in its shade" (vv. 31-32). That's a perfect illustration for the kingdom of God! The kingdom of God, eternal life, has been planted in our hearts right now and we will see it grow into something huge and beautiful on the Last day. As we wait for that Last Day, the kingdom of God can look like a little mustard seed.

When you plant a seed in the garden, nothing looks weaker. Every time I take a little seed, push it just a quarter inch deep into the ground, sweep a handful of dirt over it and sprinkle it with water, I can't help but wonder how this little seed will grow to be something beautiful. Yet it does because that's what it's supposed to do. It's the same thing with the church. God continually plants seeds, seeds of His kingdom, and then they grow against all odds. No matter what Satan tries to do to tear up the kingdom of God it will endure, because it is God's kingdom, His church, and it is promised to be eternal.

What I love most about this picture of the kingdom of God as a seed is who the gardener is. God is the Gardener and the picture we are shown doesn't flatter Him much as a gardener. In fact, we see Him throwing seeds willy-nilly all over the place. Any gardener knows that's not a very efficient way to garden, but that's how God gardens. All over His creation He throws the seeds of His kingdom and that's work you and I are called to. We are called to garden in the same way God does, throwing seeds willy-nilly and trusting that our Gardener God will do the hard work of causing those seeds to grow.

So happy gardening this week! Throw seeds of faith everywhere you go and pray to the Gardener to water and shine upon the seeds that are sown.
