Pastor's Corner for July 7-13, 2024

Lift Up Your Eyes (Psalm 123)

I have grown to love and appreciate the blue skies of North Carolina. As I water our flower and vegetable beds after we put Sophia down for the night, I often lift up my eyes and gaze at the beauty of something so simple. When my eyes are lifted toward the sky, I see so much more of God's creation! I see the massive trees in the cow pasture behind our house and the hawk's nest resting in the branches. I see the clouds, white, fluffy, and wispy. I see the sun shining bright even in the early evening. When we lift up our eyes, we see more of what God has created and the same is true for our faith life.

"To you I lift up my eyes, O you who are enthroned in the heavens!" (Psalm 123:1)

Why does the Psalmist lift up his eyes? Is it to search for God, hoping to see Him in His glory? Is it to see God and prove that He is there? Not at all! He lifts up his eyes because he knows God is there and He knows what God promises to do. As children of our Father God, we do the same.

Children always (at least until they outgrow their parents) have to lift up their eyes to see their parents. They do it out of love, but also out of need. They need to see their parents and what their parents can do for them. They also want to see their parents because they love them and want to be loved by them. When we lift up our eyes to our Heavenly Father, we certainly do it out of need. He provides for all of our needs, both the temporal and the eternal. He gives us the air we breathe, the shoes on our feet, our loved ones, and so much more. He also gives us forgiveness, mercy, compassion, love, grace, all of which leads to the heavenly home that He has promised to His children.

So keep being a kid, a child of God, and lift up your eyes to the joys of your Father's creation. Keep being a kid and lift up your eyes to the throne of mercy, where your Father sits, ready to give you all you need.
