Pastor's Corner for August 25-31, 2024

Foolishness in ALL of Us (Psalm 14, Romans 3:1-28)

Sometimes to find true Wisdom it helps to read the Old Testament through the "lens" of the New. Psalm 14 is one great example of that. At first glance it appears as if this Psalm is written only to turn our attention to the folly of "atheists": "The fool says in his heart 'There is no God'" (14:1). That message is helpful, of course, but only up to a point. As we read on in Psalm 14, we see St. Paul finding a more important insight in this Psalm that he highlights in his letter to the Romans: "None is righteous, no, not one" (3:10; cf. Ps 14:3). No one does good, St. Paul is saying. Not you. Not me. No one.

It's a sobering message... but a freeing one. Being God's Easter people means humbly and truthfully admitting our faults. It means seeing our need for newness of life and resurrection. It's like being human and recognizing our need to breathe. Our spiritual lungs are empty should we ever stop breathing in the gift of God's forgiveness! Nobody LIKES to come face-to-face with the truth that, apart from Jesus, none of us measures up in God's eyes. But that is at the center of the Christian faith journey. Luther famously wrote that Jesus' command to repent entailed that the entire life of believers was to be one of repentance (the first of his 95 Theses). Many self-help blogs will perpetuate the myth that all we need to live is inside our hearts already. It is tempting to buy into that lie. True Wisdom comes from a different location.

God-gifted humility for all starts with the cross of Jesus and His empty tomb. In the face of a challenging situation you're encountering right now, how is God calling you to be wiser? How empty are your spiritual lungs? Are you ready for a breath of fresh air?


