Pastor's Corner for September 8-14, 2024

Faith that Works (James 2:1-18)

This week we dive right into the famous text that "faith by itself, if it does not have works, is dead" (James 2:17). Labor Day, a national holiday on which we give thanks for the blessings of work in every form, is, by now, over and done with. But this week James 2 not only gives us the chance to understand work and the doing of good works better. It invites us to consider the relationship between our work and the gifts of God that animate and enliven us.

Martin Luther saw so many people of his day distracted by a kind of spiritual workaholism. He worried that many of his fellow Christians tried to defend faith as an attempt to fulfill the demands of an angry God by misreading texts like James


2:17. So he even declared James to be a "right strawy epistle" (Der Septemberbibel, 1522). In so doing, Luther wasn't saying the book of James should not be in the Bible. And he wasn't saying that doing good works wasn't important. His point was that reducing Christianity to a moralizing principle, as so many of his day were doing, would always be a misreading of the Scriptures... and ultimately, even the book of James.

Every faith in the world has something positive to say about good works done on behalf of others. But only one confesses God Almighty to have performed the most sacrificial form of loving work imaginable in the person of His own dear Son... who suffered, died on a cross, and rose from dead. That, of course, is the Christian faith! Christ not only will raise the dead on the last day. The Lord of life raises even dead faith to the living, breathing, and, yes, working faith that we long to live out each day.

James calls all who are "dead tired" from working at the Golden Rule to something new: the gift of faith that works. It's for those not working for a judge but who live under the "law of liberty" (2:12): people who know they are loved. Rather than judge others and consider some more worthy of our attention than others, James encourages us to a living, active, faith that works and makes a difference for ALL the people God puts in our paths. At RLC there are many ways to do that. Coffeehouse, Ministry to the Visually Impaired, Sleep in Heavenly Peace, "Read-a-Book/Get-a-Book," Habitat for Humanity, are just a few. Better yet: look out for that person in need at home, on the job, in your neighborhood, in the grocery store checkout, or in your doctor's office. There's no telling when or where the call to live out a working faith may come! Resting in the undeserved mercy of our Savior and King, let's look forward to seeing where God might put our faith to work again this week.
