# The Battle is Won (Revelation 12:7-12)

Revelation can be a very scary book to read, if you don't know what's going on. That's why we've been walking through select passages of The Revelation in our Bible study hour during this fall season. In its entirety and original intent, The Revelation is a letter of encouragement to the church. God gave this letter, His Word, to the church to encourage us and comfort us as we live through this time of tribulation, waiting for the final day to come when Christ returns in His glory, and we join Him in the New Creation by the resurrection! What a great and glorious day that will be!

So, what do we do with a scary passage like this one in The Revelation. A passage with verses like this, "And the great dragon was thrown down, that ancient serpent, who is called the devil and Satan, the deceiver of the whole world – he was thrown down to the earth, and his angels were thrown down with him... 'woe to you, O earth and sea, for the devil has come down to you in great wrath, because he knows that his time is short!" (vv. 9 and 12b). Not a very comforting passage, is it? Reading those two verses in isolation, which even I will admit that is where my eyes are drawn, we can be filled with fear and worry at the Biblical fact of the devil being cast down to earth and working hard in wrath and anger. Where is the hope? Where is the encouragement this letter is supposed to bring?

First, do not worry, this passage is nothing new for baptized Christians. This is something you already know. You know that the devil is at work in the world. You know the struggles and hardships that you face and that so many face in this world. You know your own sin and the battles you face. Sin is real, but so is our Savior.

Second, why is the devil working hard? Because he knows he has lost! Christ has won and His victory is our victory! The devil, no matter how hard he works, has no claim on us. He can't do anything to affect your relationship with your victorious Savior!

Nothing in The Revelation is anything you don't know. The summary of a book we often avoid out of fear and confusion, is simple. Christ has died on the cross and has risen from the grave, fulfilling the promise God put forth in Genesis 3:15, and crushing the head of Satan, grinding down with His resurrected heal, so that Satan can never touch the baptized children of God.

The devil is defeated, because Christ is Risen! He is risen indeed, Alleluia!!
