Pastor's Corner for November 17-23, 2024

Confidence in God's Presence (Hebrews 10:11-25)

There's a Japanese proverb I find interesting. Translated word for word, it comes out as "A god you keep at arms' length can't hurt you." More loosely or colloquially translated it appears in dictionaries as "leave well enough alone," or "let sleeping dogs lie." I don't want to read more into the proverb than it allows. It was never intended to make a theological statement! But its words pick up on a lamentable picture of God/the gods based on fear and nothing else. It seems to imply that not only can God/the gods be manipulated to stay at a distance; it suggests their involvement in human affairs is to bring misfortune, and little else.

The Holy Bible has a thing or two to say about the fear of the Lord. According to our status as creatures of the Divine Creator, an attitude of reverent fear toward the Maker of all things is not inappropriate. Considering our status as sinners, we can't help but adopt a posture of fear in the presence of a holy God! But the writer

of the book of Hebrews wants us to hear loud and clear that dealings with the Triune God, revealed in the person of Jesus Christ, mean there is no reason... there is no need... to keep God at arm's length! In fact, just the opposite is the case. Because of the forgiveness of sins that Jesus has won for us, we are encouraged to "draw near" to God with "our hearts sprinkle clean from an evil conscience" (10:23). We have confidence to stand even in the presence of our holy God! The curtain in the temple that separated the Holy of Holies from God's people has been torn from top to bottom, now that Jesus' one-and-only sacrifice for sins has been made. We have confidence and hope in God's presence!

All of which is important to bear in mind as we remember again during this fall season that we are getting closer to the end of the church year... are looking with hopeful anticipation toward the Day of our Lord's appearing. Let us encourage one another as people with hopeful and confident hearts all the more "as we see the Day drawing near" (10:25)!


