# Slow Down (Philippians 4:4-7)

Hope, Peace, Joy, and Love. These are the themes for the four candles on an Advent wreath. Every Sunday of Advent we light a new candle, and you may do the same at your own home. While each candle has a name and purpose, what is the goal of these candles? What are they trying to accomplish in our faith life?

When we hear those four words, Hope, Peace, Joy, and Love, they may sound like goals to accomplish during the Christmas season. Depending on the day or store you're in, they might sound like a mockery of the anxiety, loneliness, speed, and busyness of the Christmas season. But we must remember, this is not the Christmas season, this is the Advent season, and there is a difference.

As baptized children of our Father God, we live in a time of expectation. Expecting the celebration of Christ's first Advent and looking forward to His second Advent.

In-between here and there, what are we to do? How do we wait? Somedays, it feels like we are always running around in a Christmas season. Other days we may feel lost and lonely. We try and accomplish the Hope, Peace, Joy, and Love that we see light the Advent wreath, but those are not things we accomplish. They are all things that God has accomplished for you.

Hope, Peace, Joy, and Love are God's gifts that echo all throughout His Bible Story from start to finish, and in this short passage in Paul's Philippian letter, we can find all four.

"Rejoice in the Lord" not in ourselves, see the Joy of all that God has done for you! "The Lord is at hand" as Immanuel, God with us, giving us the Hope that He is with us at this very moment, preparing us for that awesome second Advent! "The Peace of God, which surpasses all understanding, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus". God's Peace is with you. It's not a feeling, it's a fact, a guarantee that we are not required to understand, but simply to live in God's Peace that you have right now. "Think about these things" of God's Love for you. The Love of God that brought Christ on that first Advent and the Love of God that will bring Christ back on that glorious second Advent.

The Advent season is meant to slow us down. I know, that seems impossible as I have my own to-do list staring at me on my desk, but remember, it's the Advent season not the Christmas season. In all the things that we work to get done during Christmas, let us remember all the work that Christ has already done for us during Advent.

# Camp Linn Haven

Camp Linn Haven is located in Avery County, North Carolina. Its mission is to provide a wholesome, safe Christian vacation setting for persons of all ages and abilities, offer opportunities to combine the camping experience with worship and devotional activities, and to encourage fellowship through the many and varied recreational activities offered by the camp. ## **Orphan Grain Train**

Orphan Grain Train is a Christian volunteer network that ships donated food, clothing, medical, and other needed items to people in 71 different countries including the United States. This group worked with Emmanuel Lutheran Church in Asheville to distribute needed items for people affected by Hurricane Helene. The aid provided included 29,000 pounds of purchased food, generators, heaters, a 5,300-gallon water tanker truck to help with the water shortage and many other disaster relief items. 
