Pastor's Corner for May 25-31, 2025

The Bride of Christ (Revelation 21:9-15, 21-27)

All throughout the Bible, God uses many different images to describe His people. In the Old Testament, there is a lot of talk about His people as His bride (Isaiah 54:4-6). In the New Testament, especially in Paul's letters, we hear God's people compared to a house (Ephesians 2:19), a family (Romans 8:15-17), and a body (1 Corinthians 12). All of them go a long way to help us understand the Church and how intimately connected we are to one another and to our Savior.

Among all these different images, my favorite may be the Church as Bride. It is a beautiful image that goes all the way back to the Garden of Eden when God walks Eve down the aisle to Adam at the first wedding in history (Genesis 2:22). Revelation adds yet another layer to this image of the Church as Bride. We are told that "the Bride, the wife of the Lamb" is "the holy city Jerusalem coming down out of heaven from God." Whoa! Church = Bride = Holy City. Make sense? Probably not, and that's ok! Let's see why this still matters.

As baptized members of God's Church, we know that we are guaranteed a place in heaven, eternally dwelling with God. On the Last Day, when Jesus returns, He will bring heaven down to earth with Him, "prepared as a bride adorned for her husband" (Rev. 21:2). There is that one word I love the most in that verse, "prepared". God has prepared us for the Last Day. God has prepared us to dwell with Himself in glory, beauty, and perfection. God is, even now, getting us ready for that unimaginably glorious day to come. What does that mean? It means that our lives are not in vain.

God has already prepared us for that day by His death and Resurrection. He came for one purpose, to bring us back to Himself through His sacrifice on the cross. We are brought into that through the waters of baptism, washed clean and prepared for the Last Day. Because we are prepared, we are not just the Bride, we will be the Holy City. What happens in cities? A lot of stuff! It is where people live, work, play, and enjoy life. It is where God will live with us for all eternity!

It is for that day that we are prepared, and so we wait for it with joy! As the Church, we are married to Jesus. As His Bride, we are also that place that He dwells, the Holy City. That starts now. At this very moment, we are already prepared as the Bride for Jesus, while He also dwells with us by the Holy Spirit. All this goes to say, that we are participating in the preparation, pointing others to Jesus, our Groom, that they too may become the Church-Bride-Holy City of the Lamb.


Mites for Missions


