- M The grace of our Lord (†) Jesus Christ and the love of God and the fellowship of the Holy Spirit be with you.
- C And also with you.
- M Sisters and brothers in Christ, Paul says in the book of Romans, chapter 3: "We know that whatever the law says, it says to those who are under the law, so that every mouth may be silenced and the whole world held accountable to God."
- C "Therefore, no one will be declared righteous in God's sight by the works of the law; rather, through the law we become conscious of our sin" (vv. 19-20).
- M This is a clear reminder that apart from God's grace and the salvation that Christ has won for us, we are lost. There is nothing we can do to earn God's favor and love. "But now apart from the law the righteousness of God has been made known, to which the Law and the Prophets testify" (v. 21). God has been merciful to us. He has sent his Son as the atoning sacrifice for our sins. Therefore, let us confess our sin to him and be assured of this love and forgiveness.
- All Holy and merciful Father, I confess that I am by nature sinful, and that I have disobeyed you in my thoughts, words, and actions. I have done what is evil and failed to do what is good. For this I deserve your punishment both now and in eternity. But I am truly sorry for my sins, and trusting in my Savior, Jesus Christ, I pray: Lord, have mercy on me, a sinner.
- M God, our heavenly Father, who is able to make all grace abound to us, has given his only Son to be the atoning sacrifice for our sins. Therefore, as a called servant of Christ and by his authority, I forgive you all your sins in the name of the Father and of the (†) Son and of the Holy Spirit.
- C Amen.
- M In the peace of forgiveness, let us praise the Lord.

## **CONFESSION OF FAITH**

The Nicene Creed

We believe in one God, the Father, the Almighty, maker of heaven and earth, of all that is, seen and unseen.

We believe in one Lord, Jesus Christ, the only Son of God, eternally begotten of the Father, God from God, Light from Light, true God from true God, begotten, not made, of one being with the Father. For our sake he was crucified under Pontius Pilate. He suffered death and was buried. On the third day he rose again in accordance with the Scriptures. We believe in the Holy Spirit, the Lord, the giver of life, who proceeds from the Father and the Son, who in unity with the Father and the Son is worshiped and glorified, who has spoken through the prophets. We believe in one holy Christian and apostolic Church. We acknowledge one baptism for the forgiveness of sins. We look for the resurrection of the dead and the life of the world to come. Amen.



However, we cannot ask someone to express agreement with us until we give that person an opportunity to discover what we teach. That is why we schedule frequent membership classes to provide an overview of our teachings.
