FAITH FORMATION

Registration is now live and can be done directly on the parish website. Our classes will begin the first Sunday in October. Registration will begin in September and can be completed online. The focus for religious education this year is "Family, Faith, and Fun!" During the monthly Sunday lesson/activity, children will explore common prayers that they should know as they develop their faith and do an activity related to that prayer. Online, families can access additional fun activities and lessons that can easily be done at home to explore themes related to the weekly scriptures of that month and/or liturgical season. At St. A's we believe the home is the primary source of faith formation and we will serve as a support for families as they work together to deepen their own faith and understanding. For children preparing to receive First Holy Communion or Confirmation, there will be additional projects later in the year that should be completed prior to the celebration of these glorious sacraments. At the time of registration, parents will be able to indicate if their child will be preparing for any sacraments this year. Children must be baptized before receiving any other sacraments.
