





With the start of a new liturgical year on December 1, we begin a new cycle of readings at mass. Each year we make available to all households the resource "At Home with the Word." This book guides you to a deeper understanding of the Sunday Scriptures, inviting you to explore the readings for Sundays and major feasts of the liturgical year, garner insights from Scripture scholars, and respond with action steps created specifically with the day's readings in mind. These books will be available beginning November 24th only while supplies last. All lectors can pick up their 2025 workbook in the sacristy before or after mass. These books are available now and will be helpful for your ministry preparations.
