

### 🗱 Entregar el niño

**AFTER THE** Baptism of a child, Hispanic godparents and parents may seal their relationship to one another and to the baby with a tradition called "Entregar el niño," or "Handing over the baby."

The brief ceremony may take place outside the church, where the parents and godparents stand in a kind of circle. The godmother, holding the baby, stands opposite the mother, and the godfather stands opposite the father.

As the godmother hands the baby over toward the mother, she says, "Comadre, here is my godchild who has come from the church with the holy sacraments and the water that [he or she] has received." The mother holds the child and says, "I receive you, my beloved charge, who have come from the church with the holy sacraments and the water that you have received."

Then the godfather takes the child and hands it over to the father, saying the same formula to his compadre. The father then holds the child and repeats the parent's formula.

The godparents then trade places, and the child is handed over and the formulas are repeated again. In this way, each of the godparents has recited the formula to each parent. They have also traced a cross as they pass the child one to another in each configuration.

When the formulas are complete, the compadres or "co-parents" embrace and say, "Compadres until death." The ritual seals the seriousness with which the godparents accept their duties.

The ceremony had even more significance when children were baptized so soon after birth that the mother could not attend. Today the parents are expected to be at the Baptism and to hold the baby during the ceremony.
