FEAST OF ST. FRANCIS & BLESSING OF ANIMALS

On **Sunday, October 5th** we will celebrate the Feast of St. Francis of Assisi with a special solemn liturgy held outdoors (weather permitting) where we will host our annual Blessing of Animals. The mass will take place on the grass where we traditionally begin our Palm Sunday liturgy. All pets should be contained or on a leash. Stuffed animals and pictures of animals will also be blessed. YOUTH FAITH FORMATION 2025-2026

This year's theme is Journey with the Saints and Seasons. Children will explore saints and the liturgical seasons of the year. Youth Faith Formation is open to children up to age 12 and classes begin on **October 5th**. You can register on the parish website. If you have a child that will be receiving a sacrament this year (Baptism, First Communion, Confirmation) then participation is required. Classes are held during the 12:30pm mass on the first Sunday of each month. There is no fee to participate.
