Presently, our church is indeed experiencing a deep summer slump in giving. Prayerfully things will improve, however, this is a good time to personally examine ourselves to see if we are being faithful in giving.

Giving is God's plan for the church to be able to minister, teach, train, evangelize, fellowship, and provide for those serving the church and so much more. God's plan means that the body of Christ at our church must be faithful to give so that we may operate. Many are so very faithful, many more are sporadic and unfortunately, some give very little or none. Our church family must be faithful to give in order to meet our present needs and to continue to do God's work in the future.

Our giving is one indication of our spiritual health. Yes, a person can give and not be right with God, however, a person cannot be right with God without being a faithful giver.

If you are faithfully giving now, thank you! Let me challenge you to give generously. If your giving is sporadic, I want to encourage you to put God first and to become regular in your giving. If you are not giving at all, then start giving.

Giving is not optional, it is God's will. When we give, we are obeying God, worshipping Him through giving and funding His work through our church family. As a member of the FBC family, we need to do our part.

Guidelines for giving:

- · Put God first, not last.
- · Give regularly (weekly, monthly, etc.)
- · Give generously (many use a tithe, 1/10, as a benchmark)
- · Give cheerfully (worship through giving)
- · Remember, 100% belongs to God.

Lastly, if any church, including ours, had the majority faithfully giving, there would be no money woes. In most churches, 20% of the people give 80% of the money. Let us see if we can do better than the average church. OUR MOTIVATION: TO OBEY AND WORSHIP THE LORD!
