“Reconciliation...always portrays God as the reconciler and sinners as the ones reconciled, since it was human sin that ruptured the relationship between God and man. Thus, reconciliation is not something man does but what he receives; it is not what he accomplishes but what he embraces. Reconciliation does not happen when man decides to stop rejecting God but when God decides to stop rejecting man. It is a divine provision by which God’s holy displeasure against alienated sinners is appeased, His hostility against them removed, and a harmonious relationship between Him and them established.” ~ John MacArthur

The Supremacy of Christ and His Reconciliation

Colossians 1:21-23

Big Truth of Today’s Message: The entirety of the Godhead resides in Jesus Christ, who by His blood has brought reconciliation to all things.

v. 21 – “And you, who once were alienated and hostile in mind, doing evil deeds...”

v. 22 – “...He has now reconciled in His body of flesh by His death, in order to present you holy and blameless and above reproach before Him...”

v. 23 – “...if indeed you continue in the faith, stable and steadfast, not shifting from the hope of the gospel that you heard, which has been proclaimed in all creation under heaven, and of which I, Paul, became a minister.”
