for the church as we continue the journey together. Speaking of being on a journey. January 6th each year always marks Epiphany. Epiphany celebrates and acknowledges the day that the star appeared to the Magi, guiding them to the Christ Child. I have long been fascinated about some of the customs that are up-



held on this day. For my family, we often begin the process of taking down our Christmas decorations on or after the 6th. I will also turn off the dusk to dawn timer on the lights that we have outside. Other customs on or around this day include things like Epiphany singing, chalking the door, having one's house blessed, consuming a Three Kings Cake, winter swimming... and others even head into church to worship!

Another custom that has been fun to watch grow in popularity over the years is the practice of picking out a Star Word. The Storehouse Food Pantry

The Storehouse food pantry, managed by Speedway Christian Church and others, served 106 families on the final Wednesday night distribution of 2022. That night, 21 volunteers helped feed 562 individual family members.

During the tough economic times of 2022, with higher prices for food and scarcity of certain food items, the numbers of people served steadily grew throughout the year. A Saturday distribution last January served 85 families representing 412 individuals. By December, a Saturday distribution served 194 families, representing 841 individuals – more than twice as many. Over the entire year, the Storehouse served 2,303 families representing 10,376 individuals.

Thank you to everyone who volunteered, and everyone who contributed food items or money. We could not have done this without you. Take a moment to appreciate that your work and your generosity made a difference for more than ten thousand people!
