And, the Chancel Choir is being directed by Holly Cecil, who is an elementary music school teacher. The choir sings each Sunday at the 10:15 am service. We are so grateful for these folks who have volunteered so that we can continue making a joyful noise each Sunday.

There is plenty of room in the choir for any of you who love to sing. The choir rehearses every Thursday evening at 7:30. No need to reserve a place as there are lots of chairs available.
