
someone reaches out to **you** that **you** might prayerfully consider saying yes. The work of the church is work that we are all called to do.

Synopsis of an article in the current AARP magazine...

In the 1950's only about 2,300 Americans reached the age of 100. Last year, more than 101,000 Americans celebrated their 100th birthday!

Tom Cole, a rabbi and co-author of The Oxford book of Aging, doesn't think you can live to an old age without a belief system, whether that's religious faith or simply a deep conviction that tomorrow holds promise.

The science backs it up. Research from Ohio State University found that religious affiliation alone can add as much as nine years to a person's life. A separate study showed that women who regularly attended religious services had a 33% lower mortality rate.
