Our Church, For Your Consideration

As we approach the change in season, we also approach some change in the life of Speedway Christian Church. This month begins the budget process as we look to the next calendar year. We would like to highlight a few things for your consideration about our current financial situation.

- Cash flow continues to be very tight. We will have to move some resources from savings to our operational
 account just to make it to year end.
- We are out of cost saving measures.
- We will have to start facing some hard realities for 2026
- Staff healthcare benefits are projected to increase
- The church office will continue to work closely with the Trustees

For example, we are even feeling the impact on our coffee and donut fellowship hour

- Donuts have increased in cost
- Donations to offset the cost of donuts have decreased
- Leaving a net deficit of about \$100/month

Prayers moving forward as we think strategically about the future God is calling us to.


