Lining up our wills with God's

A disciple of Jesus is someone who is following Jesus, is being changed by Jesus, and is committed to the mission of Jesus. (Matthew 4:19)



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# **Reflection Questions for Groups or Individuals:**

- 1. How do I get refilled or spend time alone to simply 'be' with Jesus?
  - a. How often do I spend time just being with him and what prompts it?
  - b. What do I let prevent me from this time of 'being' with him rather than 'asking' him for something or 'doing' something for him?
- 2. Who do others say Jesus is? This could be your family, neighbors, culture...
- 3. Who do you say Jesus is?
  - a. What do you base your belief of 'who he is' on?
- 4. What areas do you need help lining up your will with God's?
  - a. Do you talk with God about needing his help lining up your will with his? Surrendering our will and desires is hard but it's possible.
  - b. Where you find yourself unable to line up your will with God's? Do you know what the obstacle is?
  - c. How can friends, journey group, family, etc. help you overcome this obstacle?

# Discovery Bible Study Method for Groups or Individuals

(for more information on this method of Bible study- see https://www.dbsguide.org)

- 1. Talk: To begin the study, each person answers these questions:
  - What are you thankful for?
  - What is causing you stress?
  - Who needs our help? How can this group help them?
- 2. Look Back (session 2+)
  - Retell story from the previous meeting.
  - What did you do differently because of this story?
  - Who did you tell and what was the reaction?
- 3. Read & Re-tell
  - One person reads the Bible passage out loud, 7. Who else? and the rest follow along.
  - Someone else retells the passage by memory, if possible. Others can fill in what is missing.

### 4. Look

- Read the passage again.
- Discuss what this passage says about God, Jesus or his plan.

# 5. Look again

- Read the passage once more
- Discuss what this passage says about humans
- · Discuss what this passage says about being a disciple of Jesus

## 6. Inside me

- According to this study, what am I doing well?
- What do I need to change?

- Who needs to hear this story?
- How can I tell them?
- Who can I invite to study the Bible?
