Helping People Believe – Week 5: Preparing Your Hands

## The Big Idea

You might be the reason someone wants to believe. When you live out of God's embrace—with love, peace, humility, and a resilient hope—your life becomes a **holy invitation**. It awakens a longing in others to experience the embrace you've found in Christ. God holds out His hands to the world—and He does it through **your hands**.

# Key Insights

- Evangelism is stirring holy jealousy. God's strategy includes living lives that make others say, "I want what you have."
- Evangelism is flaunting—but not pridefully. It's showcasing God's goodness in your life to invite others in.
- Evangelism is open hands. God's hands are extended in mercy (v.21). Our lives become His visible embrace.

#### What Does Evangelism Look Like?

When we live visibly and intentionally from God's embrace, we invite others into it. Here are four powerful ways our hands extend His.

#### 1. Flaunting Our Newer Name

We live with a new identity—secured, named, and loved by God. Our confidence is not in performance but in **who we are in Christ**. That kind of settled identity provokes the world to want the same name-change.

# 2. Flaunting Our Better Community

The Church, when healthy, becomes a **countercultural community** of love, grace, and healing. The way we treat one another—with humility, forgiveness, and joy—makes the world take notice. *"By this all people will know..."* (John 13:35)



### 3. Flaunting Our Greater Peace

The world is anxious. But we rest. When we suffer and still radiate peace, it speaks volumes. "The peace of God... will guard your hearts." (Philippians 4:7)

### 4. Flaunting Our Surer Hope

We live today in light of a guaranteed tomorrow. Our generosity, perseverance, and joy—even in hardship—point to a **hope that cannot be shaken**." Always be prepared to give an answer for the hope that is in you." (1 Peter 3:15)

- 1. Can you think of a time someone's life made you want what they had (peace, joy, stability, etc.)? What stood out?
- 2. If someone observed your life closely for a week, what would they assume gives you hope or identity?

- Read Romans 10:19–21 and Romans 11:11–14
- 3. How does God describe His posture toward Israel in these verses?
- 4. What role does "jealousy" or "envy" play in God's redemptive strategy? Why might this seem surprising?

- 5. The sermon described evangelism as "flaunting God's embrace" in a holy and humble way. How is that different from boasting or self-promotion?
- 6. What do you think it means for your hands (your actions, lifestyle, relationships) to express God's open invitation?
- 7. Which of the following stood out to you most, and why?
  - o Flaunting our Newer Name
  - Flaunting our **Better Community**
  - o Flaunting our Greater Peace
  - Flaunting our Surer Hope
- 8. In what areas of life do you find it hardest to live as someone embraced by God? What needs to change for that to become more visible?

- 11. Who is someone in your life that might be watching your faith without telling you? How could your life better reflect God's embrace to them?
- 12. What's one small change you could make this week to "open your hands" to others—living in a way that invites them to explore Jesus?
