Job Description

The Youth leader must be rooted in a Biblical foundation and work to develop a teen program in the community. The Youth leader will lead by a personal example of Christian faith and worship. They will promote and implement activities for the youth as well as provide counsel and spiritual guidance.

Job Responsibilities and Duties

- Attends Sunday Worship service, rotating between the churches, once a month, on the day of the special monthly activity.
- Will lead and develop a teen program on Sunday. (Volunteer mentors from at least one church will attend and help provide coordination and support). This will incorporate spiritual education through Bible Study, devotional discussions, and possibly musical programs.
- Plan, communicate and lead one special youth event per month.
- Build and maintain relationships with teens in an appropriate and supportive manor.
- Model Christian values.
- Manage and oversee youth retreats.
- Support the community of the churches as a whole, which may occasionally require attendance and assistance at church wide events of importance.
- Lead the youth to Jesus as they are in co-discipleship with parents.

Job Definition (job skills and requirements)

- A solid grounding in the Gospel and an ability to speak to its effect in your life.
- Prior experience working with children and youth. (examples: Camp Counselor, Church/School volunteer, etc.)
- A commitment to good interpersonal relationships, teamwork, and support of church ministries.
- Ability to communicate events to parents and youth in a timely and effective manner.

Reporting

The Youth Leader reports weekly to the pastors or persons designated, about the youth activities and plans.

Hours and Compensation

The Youth Leader will work approximately 8-10 hours per week, which will include planning, weekly meetings with the youth group, attendance on Sunday mornings (negotiable), and a monthly Youth event. Compensation will be at a rate of \$800 per month plus mileage.
