

The Key To Grace James 4:7-12(ESV)

James 4:7-12 Submit yourselves therefore to God. Resist the devil, and he will flee from you. ⁸ Draw near to God, and he will draw near to you. Cleanse your hands, you sinners, and purify your hearts, you double-minded. ⁹ Be wretched and mourn and weep. Let your laughter be turned to mourning and your joy to gloom. ¹⁰Humble yourselves before the Lord, and he will exalt you. ¹¹ Do not speak evil against one another, brothers. The one who speaks against a brother or judges his brother, speaks evil against the law and judges the law. But if you judge the law, you are not a doer of the law but a judge. ¹² There is only one lawgiver and judge, he who is able to save and to destroy. But who are you to judge your neighbor?

OUR PROBLEM

- 1. Our Natural tendency is toward **PRIDE AND REBELLION**.
 - Proverbs 16:18 Pride goes before destruction, and a haughty spirit before a fall.
 - Proverbs 3:34 Toward the scorners he is scornful, but to the humble he gives favor.
 - James 4:6 But he gives more grace. Therefore it says, "God opposes the proud but gives grace to the humble."

2. We need **GRACE**.

- ➤ **Genesis 6:8** But Noah found grace in the eyes of the LORD. (NKJV)
- Romans 3:21-24 But now the righteousness of God has been manifested apart from the law, although the Law and the Prophets bear witness to it ²² the righteousness of God through faith in Jesus Christ for all who believe. For there is no distinction: ²³ for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God, ²⁴ and are justified by his grace as a gift, through the redemption that is in Christ Jesus.

OUR SOLUTION

What is the **KEY TO GRACE** and how do we get what we so **DESPERATELY NEED**?

The key to grace is <u>SUBMISSION</u>.

According To James How Do We Submit?

1. RESIST and DRAW NEAR

➤ James 4:-8 Submit yourselves therefore to God. Resist the devil, and he will flee from you. ⁸ Draw near to God, and he will draw near to you.

2. WASH and PURIFY

James 4:7-8 Submit yourselves therefore to God...Cleanse your hands, you sinners, and purify your hearts, you double-minded.

2. GRIEVE and CHANGE

➤ James 4:7, 9 Submit yourselves therefore to God... Be wretched and mourn and weep. Let your laughter be turned to mourning and your joy to gloom.

3. HUMBLE and BE EXALTED

- *James 4:7, 10* Submit yourselves therefore to God…¹⁰ Humble yourselves before the Lord, and he will exalt you.
- ➤ 1 Peter 5:6-10 Humble yourselves, therefore, under the mighty hand of God so that at the proper time he may exalt you, ⁷ casting all your anxieties on him, because he cares for you. ⁸ Be sober-minded; be watchful. Your adversary the devil prowls around like a roaring lion, seeking someone to devour. ⁹ Resist him, firm in your faith, knowing that the same kinds of suffering are being experienced by your brotherhood throughout the world. ¹⁰ And after you have suffered a little while, the God of all grace, who has called you to his eternal glory in Christ, will himself restore, confirm, strengthen, and establish you.

A MEASURE OF YOUR HUMILITY

- 1. How much do I TALK DOWN TO OR ABOUT OTHERS?
- 2. How much do I **GOSSIP OR SLANDER OTHERS**?
- 3. How much do I PUT OTHERS DOWN?
- 4. It doesn't matter if what I am saying is <u>A LIE OR 100% TRUTH</u> if I am passing along information that will cause someone to appear <u>LESS IN THE EYES OF SOMEONE</u> <u>ELSE</u> I am exhibiting a lack of <u>HUMILITY</u> or a desire to have <u>MY PRIDE STROKED</u>.

James 4:11-12 Do not speak evil against one another, brothers. The one who speaks against a brother or judges his brother, speaks evil against the law and judges the law. But if you judge the law, you are not a doer of the law but a judge. ¹² There is only one lawgiver and judge, he who is able to save and to destroy. But who are you to judge your neighbor?

- You exalt yourself <u>ABOVE THE LAW!</u>
- 2. You exalt yourself **ABOVE GOD!**

- 3. You haven't embraced fully your true **IDENTITY**!
 - > The truth is we are all in the same boat. None of us is without sin, weakness or failure!
 - Without Jesus we all <u>DESERVE HELL!</u>
