

Biblical Purpose is a statement of being. Purpose describes why you exist as a Christ-follower. It describes that which is worthy of your daily life and devotion.

Purpose is what wakes you up each morning.

Vision is what keeps you up at night.

Purpose clarifies. Vision motivates.

In a future session we will work on your personal vision (doing).

This worksheet and exercise helps you to craft your Biblical purpose; a being statement.

EXERCISE

Step One: Personal Biblical Reflection

Psalm 119:105ff describes the Word of God as a lamp and a light.

Lamp... provides guidance and hope for the immediate. Light... provides direction and courage for the future.

TWO Example Statements

These two times of reflections in the Bible help to seed your statement of Biblical purpose.

Terry Walling: I live to glorify my Lord and Savior Jesus Christ (Romans 15:5,6). I seek to personally experience the grace and truth of the Gospel (John 1:14), in order to demonstrate an authentic walk with Christ to believers ensuared in religion and unbelievers trapped in darkness.

Another Leader: I exist to be a loyal friend and passionate soldier of the Warrior King Jesus, extending His territory behind enemy lines, for the greater glory of God.
