This application is for the Arthur E. & Virginia M. Sergeant Scholarship. It is a completely separate application from the other Presbyterian scholarships. Both forms must be filled out completely, including all attachments, if you want to be considered for the scholarships.

The Arthur & Virginia Sergeant Scholarship Trust

Relevant information regarding this Scholarship is as follows:

1. The Scholarship shall be administered and the recipient decided upon by the Scholarship Committee of the First Presbyterian Church, Fort Dodge, Iowa with announcement made at an appropriate ceremony at the school from which the winner is selected.
2. Scholarship winner will be selected annually in April of each year based upon the following criteria:
 - a. To any graduating high school senior from Fort Dodge Senior High or St. Edmonds High School, or to a graduating high school senior who is a current member on the active rolls of the First Presbyterian Church of Fort Dodge but whose high school may be other than in the City of Fort Dodge;
 - b. That the recipient be an entering freshman in any properly accredited two or four year college;
 - c. That it is not simply an academic scholarship but open to any student who exhibits during high school exceptional qualities even though he or she may be an 'average' student academically;
 - d. If the recipient is not Presbyterian, he or she must have a strong church relationship or exhibit high Christian or Judeo-Christian ideals;
 - e. The recipient is a well-rounded student with active involvement in school related extracurricular activities such as athletics or music. In addition, consideration should also be given to the student's non-school involvement in community activities and service and display good citizenship in such endeavors;
 - f. Financial need is a factor in determining the recipient.
3. The fund of the Scholarship will be sent to the registrar of the recipient's college upon proof of enrollment for disbursement for the college expenses of the recipient. The scholarship will be for a full school year and paid in equal parts based upon the school's academic year i.e. semester or quarterly basis. Funds not used for any reason will be returned to the scholarship fund and a scholarship so awarded will lapse if the recipient:
 - a. Fails to enroll during the year in which the Scholarship is awarded in a course of study meeting the criteria as a full time student in the accredited two or four year college;
 - b. Fails to continue such course of study.
4. The Scholarship Committee may make exceptions to the above if the circumstances warrant. The recipient may be asked by the Committee to report periodically on their progress.
5. Application forms can be obtained either from school officials, the First Presbyterian Church, 111 5th Avenue N., Fort Dodge, Iowa 50501 or on the First Presbyterian Church website at: fpcfd.org/information/scholarship-applications/. The application shall include letters of recommendation, one from the high school principal, a teacher, or counselor, and one from a Minister or church/synagogue officer, on forms comprising part of the application. The application of each candidate must be turned in to the Scholarship Committee at the First Presbyterian Church on or before 10:00 am on April 1st.
