In our nation, November always holds an election day - an opportunity of sacred importance that should never be taken for granted (even in midterms). This year, in our parish and diocese, there are additional very important decisions before us. In every decision of our lives, may we keep a few things in mind:

- God cares! God cares about our lives, communities, and relationships. God loves each person, each candidate, fully. And so our engagement in processes that impact people and communities (and <u>how</u> we engage) are matters of spiritual importance.
- Seek to become informed! May we ask questions and read/listen carefully, recognizing the differences between opinion and fact, which both have their places.
- Pray! May we ask God to guide us, and then may we listen and follow.

Vestry Nomination Process

The Vestry of St. Mary's has a vital role in the leadership of this parish, and St. Mary's will soon elect its next 4-person class of vestry leaders.

- 1. On **October 12th**, a preliminary list of members who are eligible to serve on the vestry was posted in the church. The parish office needed any necessary corrections by **Sunday**, **October 24th**.

- 2. On **November 1st**, a Vestry nomination form will be emailed and posted in the Narthex with instructions on the "Nomination by Ballot" process.
- 3. The Vestry's Nominating Committee (consisting of the 4 out-going members) is entrusted to discern a 4-person candidate slate informed by the nomination ballots received and based on the needs of the parish.
- 4. The Annual Parish Meeting will take place during the 10:30am liturgy on **Sunday, December 7th, 2025**. At that time, voting for the 4-person slate will take place. Please plan now to attend worship this joyous and significant day!

Serving on the Vestry of St. Mary's Church is service to our Lord and is an honor and privilege. Please be in prayer for discernment about who you sense may be called to serve in this way. May God bless the leadership of this church.


LEARN ABOUT THE CAMINO DE SANTIAGO!



All Saints Sunday, November 2nd For all the saints, who from their labors rest



All Saints worship is a deeply meaningful Principal Feast Day of the Church that will be observed this year on **Sunday, November 2nd.** During the Christian Formation hour (9:30am) that morning, we are excited to share an intergenerational activity where all classes (adults too!) will meet in Moseley Hall after breakfast to put together care packages and write encouraging notes for our college students while playing "All Saints Jeopardy." Come join in the fun! We will be joined by Rev. Ron Abrams, who will serve as officiant and preacher and will offer special words regarding Consecration Sunday (the following Sunday, November 9th). Fr. Ron began his ministry in New York, where he was Assistant Rector of St. Mark's in Westhampton Beach from 1982 to 1984, followed by seven years as Rector of St. Ann's Church in Bridgehampton from 1984 to 1991. In 1991, Ron embarked on a new chapter, coming to North Carolina as Rector of Holy Trinity Church in Fayetteville. During his time there, he

devoted himself to supporting military families and shared his expertise as a guest lecturer for the Bishop of the Armed Forces at conferences in Japan and Germany. He then served a 20-year tenure as Rector of St. James' Parish in Wilmington from 1999 to 2019, followed by serving as Priest in Charge at Holy Trinity Church in Hampstead from 2019-2025. Most recently Ron has served as the summer ministry coordinator for the worship community on Figure 8 Island, NC. Ron is married to Kathleen, an accomplished interior designer, and together they have two sons and four grandchildren.

Music Notes



Dear St. Mary's Family,

Several weeks ago, a group of people met after church to discuss the possibility of beginning a concert series at St. Mary's for our church and for the community at large. We have already established a music tradition in the community with our Boar's Head Festival each year that draws a huge following, so we would like to build upon that tradition with a concert series that offers outstanding musical performances within the program year. The decision was made to host the Ciompi Quartet from Duke University as our first event on Sunday, March 22nd, 2026. For those who are not

familiar with the Ciompi Quartet, they are a world renowned string quartet centered at Duke University in Durham, N.C. who are known for their skill and finesse in interpreting string music of all musical genres. As our first event, they will set a high standard for the quality of music in our series that will help build a reputation of excellence in the region to include not only Kinston but surrounding areas such as Greenville, Goldsboro, New Bern, and Jacksonville. I feel confident that there are few churches anywhere that are as beautiful and that offer such a rich acoustical environment as St. Mary's. There is no better place anywhere to share beautiful music!

It will take financial support to launch a series at St. Mary's. The cost of the Ciompi Quartet is \$4,000.00, and we have already received several donations. 
