

Did you know that May the Fourth is "Star Wars Day?" Now, it's not on the church calendar, but if you decide to celebrate anyways, I'd love to hear about it! I have always really enjoyed the Star Wars movies, and as a dad, I've especially enjoyed watching more and more of the growing Star Wars 'canon' with my family. There are so many interesting storylines and

characters, not to mention the imagination behind the worlds and cultures that have been created. But it is "The Force" that is on my mind as I write today: that invisible, but living, powerful, and mysterious entity that is as important a "character" in Star Wars as any other.


### The Holy Spirit is

entecost is a Principle Feast Day of the church, celebrated on the seventh Sunday after Easter. This year, Pentecost Sunday is May 19th. While there is an ancient Jewish holiday of the same name, for Christians, Pentecost commemorates the gift of the Holy Spirit to the Apostles and other followers of Jesus while they were in Jerusalem observing the Jewish custom. Because the Holy Spirit has inspired the spread of the Good News of Jesus to the world, Pentecost is often understood to be the birthday of the Church. Happy Birthday!!! On this day, the clergy wear RED vestments, and the altar will be adorned with red hangings. It is even customary for the people of the congregation to wear RED as well. We look forward to celebrating this Feast Day with you!

SAM HOLT MINISTER OF MUSIC


