

IMPACT GROUP QUESTIONS

KEY PASSAGE: LUKE 24:13-27, 32-34

Opening: What truths impacted you most from the sermon/passage? *Praise Him: Jesus meets us where we are; Believe in Him: Jesus shows us who He is in Scripture; Worship Him: He is risen!*

INFORM THE HEAD/STIR THE HEART

Please read Luke 24:13-27, 32-34 and answer the following questions:

1. Verse 14 says the two men were “talking with each other about all these things that had happened.” What things were “these things”?

2. According to verse 16, why didn't the two men recognize Jesus? What reasons might God have had for this?

3. What words or phrases from verses 17-21 do you see that help you understand their demeanor?

4. What did the two men share in verses 22-24 that could have given them hope? Why do you think we sometimes focus more on the things that cause fear or seem hopeless than the things that inspire trust and give hope?

5. From verses 25-27, how did Jesus respond? For what purpose do you think He was sharing the things He spoke about?

6. From verse 32, what does it feel like when God is stirring? How do we respond to the word when He is stirring? How does that impact our worship?

CHALLENGE THE WILL

What is one thing from this passage that you will apply to your life—in your actions, thoughts, or desires—to better center your worship on the Lord?
