KEY PASSAGE: MARK 4:35-41

Opening: What truths impacted you most from the sermon/passage? *Rest assured, Jesus cares; Trust the Creator King who has the authority to command the wind and waves.*

INFORM THE HEAD/STIR THE HEART

Please read Mark 4:35-41 and answer the following questions:

1. Please look ahead to Mark 5. For what reason did Jesus want to pass over to the other side of the Sea of Galilee? What does this tell you about His care for all people?

2. Please give possible reasons you think other boats accompanied Jesus and the disciples. What insight do your reasons give you about the draw to Jesus?

3. Please look back at what Jesus was doing right before this passage. How do verses 36 and 38a show about His humanity?

4. How did the disciples' response to the great storm show both their faith and their lack of faith in Jesus?

5. How did Jesus' response to the disciples' accusation display His authority, power, and love?

6. Please consider Jesus' questions in verse 40. What truths about Him do you need to focus on to help you trust Him when you're in the middle of a storm?

7. Do you have any storms brewing in your life? What might it look like to trust in Jesus in the face of the storm?

What is one thing from this passage that you will apply to your life—in your actions, thoughts, or desires—to better center your worship on the Lord?
