

IMPACT GROUP QUESTIONS

KEY PASSAGE: LUKE 8:40-56

Opening: What truths impacted you most from the sermon/passage? *Bow before Jesus in humble trust; Believe in the miraculous, healing power of Jesus; My God can. My God will. Even if He doesn't, I will worship Him.*

INFORM THE HEAD/STIR THE HEART

Please read Luke 8:40-56 and answer the following questions:

1. What do you think people saw in Jesus that caused so many to wait for His return after His quick trip to cast out the legion of demons from a Gentile man?

2. Please describe how Jairus, a ruler of the synagogue, approached Jesus. How was his approach different than most religious leaders of that time?

3. How did the woman who Jesus healed approach Him? How was her approach similar to Jairus, and how was it different?

4. If either Jairus or the woman had been filled with pride, how might they have handled their situations?

5. What did Jesus commend in the woman, and what did He call for in Jairus in verses 48 and 50? How can fear become an obstacle to that?

6. What do you think Jairus must have been thinking when Jesus stopped for the woman, and then was told that his child had died? How do you think what happened next impacted his view of Jesus?

7. Throughout this passage, how did Jesus display that He was not motivated by or concerned for the approval of man? How did His lack of concern make Him more loving, not less?

8. Of the people in this passage, which do you relate to the most and why? What do you learn about Jesus that helps you in your circumstances?

What is one thing from this passage that you will apply to your life—in your actions, thoughts, or desires—to better center your worship on the Lord?
