

IMPACT GROUP QUESTIONS

KEY PASSAGE: JOHN 4:16-26

Opening: What truths impacted you most from the sermon/passage? *Worship Jesus with humility and transparency; Recognize that worship is not about where, but who; Approach your King in spirit and truth.*

INFORM THE HEAD / STIR THE HEART

1. Why was it a big deal that Jesus was talking with a Samaritan woman? How can we, as Gentiles, draw hope from that?

2. Why do you think Jesus revealed to the woman that He knew her living conditions when she asked Him for the living water?

3. Jesus told the woman, "True worshipers will worship the Father in spirit and truth."

- a. What does worshiping in spirit and truth look like?

- b. Please describe the opposite of worshiping in spirit and truth.

4. In verse 21, Jesus referred to the woman at the well as "Woman." This was a sign of respect in their culture. What does this tell you about how Jesus approaches us in our circumstances?

5. Why do you think Jesus revealed to the woman that He was the Messiah when He wasn't yet revealing it to the Jews?

6. In verses 27-29, with her sin revealed by Jesus, why do you think the Samaritan woman felt safe to be with Jesus and invite others to come to him?

7. What attributes of Jesus do you see in this passage, and which is most meaningful to you in your current circumstances?

CHALLENGE THE WILL

Based on what you learned in Sunday's message and in your study time, what is one measurable thing you will go after this week in your walk with Christ?
