IMPACT GROUP QUESTIONS

KEY PASSAGE: 2 TIMOTHY 2:22-26

Opening: What truths impacted you most from the sermon/passage? *Flee youthful passions. Pursue your God of love and holiness; Serve the Lord in your kindness, clarity and patience; Pray that your sincere walk will impact those around you all for His glory.*

INFORM THE HEAD / STIR THE HEART

1. Verse 22 starts with the word “So,” which is like “therefore.” Please look back at verses 20-21 and explain why Paul calls us to “flee youthful passions.”

2. How do “youthful passions” prevent us from pursuing “righteousness, faith, love, and peace”?

3. Please describe the following words including their opposite meanings, and how we can pragmatically pursue them:

a. Righteousness

b. Faith

c. Love

d. Peace

4. Please use the following passages to explain how joining others who “call on the Lord from a pure heart” can help us in our pursuit of God:

a. Psalm 119:63

b. Proverbs 23:20

c. 1 Corinthians 15:33

5. What kinds of foolish, ignorant controversies do we get caught up into in our culture? According to verses 24-25, what should we be pursuing instead?

6. What fears or concerns get in the way of living out verses 24-25? Why do you think God wants to involve us in His plan to help others turn to Him?

7. What hope is given in verse 25, and what do you learn about the character of God from verses 22-26?
